NONDISCRIMINATION PROGRAM POLICY

The Town of Oakland, TN Title VI Program (Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987) is to ensure nondiscrimination of its programs and services and to promote and engage the participation of all people regardless of race, religion, color, national origin, sex, age, disability and socioeconomic status.

Every effort will be made to ensure nondiscrimination with any and all Town of Oakland services. If you believe you have been discriminated against based on race, religion, color or national origin, sex, age, disability and socioeconomic status you have the right to file a complaint.
