Old Business

Oakland Design Review Guidelines Discussion: Christina Hall spoke about the proposed exterior building colors and provided Sherwin Williams color palettes (swatches). The colors were divided into neutral, earthtone, and accent colors. The proposed colors will be included in the revised Guidelines once completed and approved by the Commission. Mr. Courton would recommend expanding the colors for buildings and dividing the colors into primary and secondary colors based on building percentage. Commission discussion ensued about the colors. Mr. Courton says that he would recommend the Commission consider allowing staff to administrative approve compliant colors and other elements of the Guidelines. Mr. Courton will provide the Commission staff's recommendations at an upcoming meeting. Commission discussion continued regarding exterior window lighting. Mr. Courton says this issue is difficult

to enforce but will look into it, as part of the revised Guidelines. Mr. Courton further addressed staff's consistent enforcement problem with corner lot fences. Steve Laskoski, Chairman Laughlin and Christina Hall are concerned about staff's lack of enforcement. Mr. Courton says staff is addressing many issues and it is about enforcement priorities, staff time and funding.
