

RESOLUTION NO. 25-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND, TENNESSEE, APPROVING MOBILE FOOD VENDOR PERMITS FOR AMIGOS AND CAIRO GYRO FOOD TRUCKS

WHEREAS, the Town of Oakland seeks to support small businesses and local food vendors in a safe and regulated manner; and

WHEREAS, Amigos Food Truck, located at 14670 Highway 194, and Cairo Gyro, located at the Exxon station at 3340 Highway 64, have both submitted applications for operation as mobile food vendors within the town limits; and

WHEREAS, both vendors have successfully completed and passed all required inspections conducted by the Town's Codes Department and Fire Marshal; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen finds that both businesses have met all operational and safety requirements in accordance with local ordinances, and no further objections have been raised by the community or town officials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That **Amigos Food Truck**, located at 14670 Highway 194, is hereby approved for operation as a mobile food vendor within the Town of Oakland for a period of **one (1) year**, commencing on the date of this resolution's adoption.
2. That **Cairo Gyro**, located at the Exxon station at 3340 Highway 64, is likewise approved for operation as a mobile food vendor within the Town of Oakland for a period of **one (1) year**, commencing on the date of this resolution's adoption.
3. That these approvals are contingent upon continued compliance with all applicable health, fire, and safety codes and subject to immediate revocation in the event of any violations.


