

RESOLUTION 25-23

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND, TENNESSEE PROVIDING
AUTHORIZATION TO THE MAYOR TO RENEW A CONTRACT
AGREEMENT WITH FAYETTE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION**

WHEREAS, The Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the Town of Oakland, Tennessee (the Town) wish to renew an agreement with the Fayette County Board of Education (the Fayette County Board); and,

WHEREAS, this agreement allows the Town of Oakland Parks & Recreation the use of the baseball/softball/soccer fields located adjacent to and being a part of the Oakland Elementary School and West Jr. High School ("Ball Fields"); and the gymnasiums, restrooms and concession areas located within Oakland Elementary and West Junior High Schools for organized events; and,

WHEREAS, in return, the Town agrees to pay the Fayette County Board a negotiated and agreed upon amount and will maintain and repair fields as specified by the Agreement.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND
ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:**

That the Mayor be authorized to execute an agreement between the Town and the Fayette County Board of Education for the use of school owned property within and adjacent to Oakland Elementary School and West Junior High School by the Town's Parks & Recreation Department, a copy of said agreement being attached hereto designated Exhibit "A".

A motion was made by Alderman Cates that Resolution 25-23 be adopted. The motion was seconded by Alderman Campbell. All in favor, none opposed. Resolution 25-23 passed.


The Mayor declared the resolution duly adopted and effective from and after this 17th day of July, 2025.
