WHEREAS, the Town of Oakland now seeks to participate in this important program.



SECTION 1. That the Town of Oakland is hereby authorized to submit application for a "Safety Partners" Matching Grant Program through Public Entity Partners.


SECTION 2. That the Town of Oakland is further authorized to provide a matching sum to serve as a match for any monies provided by this grant.
