

RESOLUTION 25- 33

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF OAKLAND TO SEEK
AUTHORIZATION FOR LOCAL ELECTRICAL INSPECTIONS**

WHEREAS, all electrical inspections in the Town of Oakland are currently conducted by and through the State of Tennessee Fire Marshall's Office; and

WHEREAS, State Law allows municipalities to make application to the State Fire Marshall to authorize electrical inspections to be conducted within the municipality by properly certified local inspectors, who are either employed by the municipality or who are contracted by the municipality to perform such inspections; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Oakland is of the opinion that it is in its best interests that all electrical inspections be conducted locally and that said local inspection authority be authorized by the State of Tennessee Fire Marshall; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its effort to seek local electrical inspection authority, the Town, by and through its building inspector Joe McDonald, has completed the required application and audit questionnaire required by the Fire Marshall to be submitted in order to initiate the request for local inspection authorization and therefore seeks the approval of the Town's Board of Mayor and Alderman to submit said application to the State Fire Marshall.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF OAKLAND'S BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the application for local electrical inspection authorization prepared by the Town's Building Inspector, Joe McDonald, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution designated Exhibit "A", is hereby approved for submittal to the State of Tennessee Fire Marshall's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Board further approves any and all additional steps and undertakings required by the State of Tennessee in order for the Town to obtain authorization for local electrical inspections.


