

ORDINANCE 25-10

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL A PORTION OF ORDINANCE 23-24 RELATING TO
PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, TRANSIENT VENDORS AND STREET BARKERS**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 23-24 adopted December 21, 2023, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen amended Title 9, Sections 101(1) and 101(2) by revising language contained therein in order to specifically exclude dwellings from those places that peddlers and solicitors are allowed to go; and,

WHEREAS, it is now deemed in the public interest to repeal Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance 23-24 and fully reinstate the language contained within the Town's Municipal Code Title 9-101(1) and (2).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Sections 1 and 2 set forth in Ordinance 23-24 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That the language contained within Sections 1 and 2 set forth in Town Municipal Code Title 9-101 is hereby reinstated.


SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the passage of the second and final reading, the public welfare so requiring.


