

RESOLUTION NUMBER 25-29

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE
CHARTER FOR THE TOWN OF OAKLAND,
TENNESSEE BE AMENDED.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Oakland, Tennessee (Town) was provided a new charter as set out in Chapter 167 of the Private Acts of 1994 by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, the Town's Charter was amended by Chapter 39 of the Private Acts of 2020, by Chapter 52 of the Private Acts of 2022, by Chapter 30 of the Private Acts of 2023, and by Chapter 26 of the Private Acts of 2025; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town to further amend the Charter so as to delete certain provisions and to add new provisions; and


WHEREAS, the interests of the Town of Oakland will be served if the Charter of the Town is so amended;


NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND, TENNESSEE, that the Board hereby requests that the Honorable Ron Gant introduce the attached proposed act to the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee in order to amend the Charter for the Town of Oakland, Tennessee.

A motion was made by Vice Mayor Cates to accept Resolution 25-29. Alderman Campbell seconded the motion. Yea votes were cast by Alderman Campbell, Austin, LaBudde and Bailey. None Opposed. By a vote of 5 to 0, Resolution 25-29 passed unanimously.
