

RESOLUTION 26-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND, TENNESSEE PROVIDING AUTHORIZATION FOR THE OAKLAND WATER DEPARTMENT TO SOLICIT PROPOSALS FOR FIRE HYDRANT MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the Town of Oakland, Tennessee has authorized the Town's Water Department to solicit proposals for fire hydrant maintenance services; and,

WHEREAS, a priority of the Town's Water Department is to maximize water quality and water main cleanliness; and,

WHEREAS, It is essential for public safety to properly inspect, flush and test fire hydrants in order to ensure that water will be available wherever and whenever an emergency occurs; and,

WHEREAS, Insurance Service Office (ISO) Ratings are favorably impacted by regularly maintained hydrants and as a consequence thereof, citizens of the community stand to benefit from lower insurance premiums.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OAKLAND MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN, as follows:

1. **Authorization to Solicit Bids** – The Town Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare a formal Invitation to Bid for the Fire Hydrant Maintenance Program, in accordance with applicable procurement laws and regulations.
2. **Scope of Work** – The bid solicitation shall include, hydrant flushing/flow testing, maintain hydrant service records, hydrant maintenance, repairs & replacements and mapping.
3. **Publication** – Notice of the Invitation to Bid shall be published in the Fayette Falcon and posted on the municipal website for a minimum of 5 days prior to the bid opening date.

4. **Bid Opening** – All bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud at Oakland City Hall and evaluated in accordance with the criteria set forth in the bid documents.
5. **Effective Date** – This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


