**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND, TENNESSEE AUTHORIZING
THE TRANSFER OF REMAINING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDS TO THE
TOWN'S WASTEWATER FUND**

WHEREAS, The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) was signed into law on March 11, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Oakland received ARPA funds, and established a separate account for the receipt, administration, control and reporting of such funds; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Oakland has complied with all applicable federal requirements and deadlines governing the obligation and expenditure of ARPA funds; and,

WHEREAS, following the completion of all eligible ARPA expenditures, a remaining balance of \$470,635.67 remains in the Town's ARPA account; and,

WHEREAS, the Town's Finance Director has consulted with the Town's independent audit firm and the Office of the Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury, both of which have advised that the remaining balance may be transferred to the Town's Wastewater Fund and that the ARPA Account may thereafter be closed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND, TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1: The Finance Director is authorized and directed to transfer the sum of \$470,635.67 from the Town's ARPA Account ending in 5794 to the Town's Wastewater Account ending in 5796.

SECTION 2: Upon completion of the transfer authorized herein, the Town Recorder is authorized and directed to close the Town's ARPA Account ending 5794.
